1. **K. cxix, 7, 1.**—"A general map of New France, commonly called Canada;" drawn to shew a mode of breaking "the communication of the French settlements by building a strong fort at the mouth of the river Condé, a second on the south side of the Lake Huron, and a third at the river des François; drawn on a scale of 160 English miles to an inch: 1 f. 2 in. \times 11 in.
2. **K. cxix, 16.**—A colored "plan of the River of Catarouqui or Galette, the S.W. fork of the River St. Lawrence," from Lake Ontario to Lake St. François; drawn on a scale of 4 miles (?) to an inch: 2 f. 8 in. \times 9 in.

4. **K. cxix, 24.**—"A plan of the town of Montreal," shewing General Amherst's and General Murray's Encampments; drawn on a scale of 800 feet to an inch: 2 f. 8 in. \times 1 f. 5 in.

14. **K. cxix, 34**—"Plan of the town of Quebec, in Canada, enlarged from Bellin's plan, with additions," drawn (and signed) by Pat. Mackellar, Engr. Ord., on a scale of 400 feet to an inch: 1 f. 4½ in. \times 1 f. 2 in.
15. **K. cxix, 35.**—A "Plan of Quebec, relative to the state of defence of the Fortifications; with the projected Citadel;" a rough sketch, drawn apparently soon after the capture of the place by Wolfe, on a scale of 570 feet to an inch: 1 f. 8 in. \times 1 f. 2 in.
16. **K. cxix, 36.**—A colored "Plan de la ville de Quebec, 1759;" drawn on a scale of 47½ toises to an inch: 2 f. 4 in. \times 1 f. 8 in. It is endorsed "Lt. Col. Symes."

22. **K. cxix, 40.**—A "plan of Montreal;" drawn by J. A. in 1756, on a scale of 10 toises to an inch: 1 f. 10 in. \times 1 f. 1 in.

24. **K. cxix, 42, b.**—"A view of the city of Montreal, in Canada, taken from the top of the mountain;" drawn by James Peachey, 15th Oct., 1784: 2 f. \times 1 f. 6 in.

26. **K. cxix, 43, 3.**—A "Plan of Fort St. John, on the River Chambly;" drawn by Captain Gother Mann, Eng^r., Quebec, 7th May, 1791, on a scale of 200 feet to an inch; with sections on a scale of 20 feet to an inch: 2 f. 3 in. \times 1 f. 7 in.

28. **K. cxix, 43, 4.**—A colored "Plan and Sections of the New Works proposed at St. John's;" drawn by Captain Gother Mann, Quebec, 7th May, 1791; the plan on a scale of 200 feet to an inch, the sections on a scale of 20 feet to an inch: 2 f. 9 inches \times 1 f. 10 in.
